

## Meeting at <u>South County Secondary School</u> Tuesday, October 13, 2015 @ 7 PM

## \*\*\*\* MINUTES\*\*\*\*

**1.** President Nick Firth called the meeting to order at 7 p.m.

**Motion** made to approve the September 8 meeting minutes which was seconded and approved unanimously.

**Motion** made to approve the 7-11 on Armistead and Lorton to replace their tanks and change a Kerosene pump to gas pump, which was seconded and passed unanimously.

2. Nick explained that this is not a regular South County Federation meeting so that time can be given to a candidates' debate to provide members an opportunity to meet the candidates for the November 3 election and hear their positions on key issues affecting our community. Candidates who participated were:

Vernon School Board Elizabeth L. Schultz – Springfield School Board – unopposed

President Firth moderated and asked 18 questions that were submitted in advance by the members. Questions included: candidate's priorities; school funding, cutting music/art classes, school shootings, being competitive with neighboring counties, class sizes, boundary studies; gun measures; mental health concerns; continuing to look to the Federation as a resource in land use issues and opening a satellite office in the South County area for improved access; enforcing Lorton landfill provisions to close on December 31, 2018; transportation priorities; alleviating southbound traffic onto Lorton Road; Route 1 expansion and public transportation; increasing economic opportunities; and standing up to predatory lenders. Candidates provided opening and closing remarks and answered questions.

Nick acknowledged Scout Troop 688 who were in attendance of the meeting.

Motion made and seconded to adjourn the meeting. Nick adjourned the meeting at 9:25 p.m.
