



RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2002, Fairfax County received title to the former D.C. Department of Corrections facility at Lorton. As a result of this transfer, certain Areas were specifically designated for park use;

WHEREAS, the original plans for the Laurel Hill Common Green included a restroom facility which has not been funded under the current contract;

WHEREAS, the SCF has worked diligently to both support and move forward the enacting of the designated park plans, most recently requesting that Mount Vernon District Supervisor Dan Storck request the park bond funds provided for what was then known as the Northern Section of Giles Road Extension, which remains in the Comprehensive Plan (albeit now unfunded) be transferred to the Fairfax County Park Authority for the Laurel Hill Common Green;

WHEREAS, in a recent update on the status of the construction of the Laurel Hill Common Green which was presented to the SCF, it was revealed that the construction funds did not include the originally designed and promised restroom facilities for that park;

WHEREAS, there are no adequate restroom facilities in any convenient proximity to the park, these restroom facilities being essential and integral to family and citizen usage and enjoyment of their experience at this park;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the SCF requests and call upon the Fairfax County Park Authority in partnership with the Mount Vernon District Supervisor's



office to complete the construction of this park facility, with the required restroom facilities during calendar year 2020; and

FURTHER, that the promised and designed restroom facilities be constructed taking advantage of the latest energy and water efficient technologies, so as to further demonstrate the Fairfax County commitment to energy efficiency and environmental awareness; and

FURTHER, that needed funds should be obtained from the original Fairfax County Park Authority Bond Premium Funding and/or the transfer and earmarking of excess “year end” funds within the Fairfax County budget.
