
## Watch your speed on Silverbrook


## Workhouse Master Plan

## County Space Planning focuses on Lorton

The County has modified its Site-Specific Plan Amendment Process and that has led to several applications for future development in the South County region. The Federation has been supportive of converting office space into housing near Saratoga shopping center, but is against a plan to build townhomes along Old Ox Rd near the Workhouse. A plan to build a drive thru Starbucks at the Shoppes of Lorton Valley is also under consideration.
