Lorton Road, Crosspointe streets to be repaved

The Northern Virginia Paving Program has an updated Paving Status Map and Lorton Rd and parts of Crosspointe are on it. Approximately 37 miles of roadway will be resurfaced within the Federation this year, with Lorton Rd, from Silverbrook to Rte 1, the most utilized. Additional roads to be repaved include Oak Chase Ct, Plaskett Ln, Bayberry Ridge Rd, and Triple Ridge Rd. Visit VirginiaDOT.org/projects/ for more information.
